2009 CONSTRUCTION SEASON STATE ROUTE 28 ROAD WORK CLOSURES AND DETOURS

STATE ROUTE 28 ROAD WORK

Phase I
Road Closed May 3 - May 22
 State Route 28 from U.S. 50 to Sand Harbor closed to traffic (except emergency vehicles) from 7 p.m. Sundays through 5 a.m. Fridays. **Road open with no delays on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.**

Phase II
Road Restricted May 22 - July 2
 Traffic reduced to one lane with a pilot car from Sand Harbor to East Lakeshore Boulevard. Motorists can expect half-hour delays. **Road open with no delays on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.**

DETOUR ROUTE OPTIONS

Detour 1
 To access Reno or the Carson Valley, Mt. Rose highway would be the quickest. There is the option of driving around Lake Tahoe via North Shore to South Lake to access Spooner and the Carson Valley.

Detour 2
 SR 267 from north shore to Truckee then to Reno

Once Phase II begins, traffic will be subjected to NDOT's standard allowable delays; the traffic can be stopped for up to 20 minutes and delayed for no more than 30 minutes.

Road Closed May 3 - May 22

State Route 28 from U.S. 50 to Sand Harbor closed to traffic (except emergency vehicles) from 7 p.m. Sundays through 5 a.m. Fridays. Road open with no delays on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Road Restricted May 22 - July 2

Traffic reduced to one lane with a pilot car from Sand Harbor to East Lakeshore Boulevard. Motorists can expect half-hour delays. Road open with no delays on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Road closures are related to a \$5 million project to resurface SR 28 from U.S. 50 to East Lakeshore Boulevard. Closing SR 28 for 3 weeks will allow roadway resurfacing from

U.S. 50 to East Lakeshore Boulevard in eight weeks as opposed to more than sixteen weeks by closing only one lane. Motorists would still be subjected to delays of up to an hour if only one lane were kept open.
